AGM and Trophy Presentation Day - Saturday 4th September

Presentation Day for 2010 is being held at Aussie World, Frizzo Road. Players and their immediate family (parents; grandparents; siblings) are invited to attend. Gates will open at 3.45 pm. Presentation of trophies will commence at 4.30pm sharp. Everyone (over the age of 2) will be charged \$5 entry. There are **NO** EFTPOS facilities available - cash only. If you wish to only attend the Presentation of Trophies, a full refund will be given if you leave prior to 6.30pm. Exclusive use of Rides from 6.30pm to 8.30pm. (Rides will not commence until after presentation of trophies has been completed). Side Show Alley available at 1/2 price ie \$2. NO food or drink is allowed to be brought in. Cafe facilities will be open.

Players are to sit with their team at the front of the hall. It is recommended that they bring a picnic rug or blanket to sit on. As the Club has 36 teams (420 players), it is imperative that the times are adhered to. It is asked that players remain seated quietly before and after their team has been presented with their trophies as a sign of courtesy for all their fellow players.
